INITIATED AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE ACTIVITIES OF ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA

DURING HIS 1975 STAY IN SANTIAGO. CIA REPORTED THAT THE DIRECTOR

OF DINA WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN HAVING CHILEAN PRESIDENT PINOCHET

JAIMES VASQUEZ WAS EXTREMELY UPSET AND DEJECTED OVER A RECENT OFFICIAL SANCTION AGAINST HIM WHICH INCLUDED A TEN-DAY SENTENCE WHICH CONFINED HIM TO IC HEADQUARTERS, REMOVAL FROM HIS POSITION AS INTERPOL DIRECTOR AND A TRANSFER FROM SANTIAGO TO AN IC RESIDENT AGENCY IN PUERTO MONT, A REMOTE SOUTHERN AREA OF CHILE. VASQUEZ EXPLAINED THAT DURING THE LAST WEEK OF SEPTEMBER, 1976, A SERIES OF ACCUSATIONS WERE MADE BY THE NUMBER TWO MAN IN IC CONCERNING ALLEGED MISCONDUCT BY VASQUEZ TO GENERAL BAEZA. VASQUEZ ADVISED THAT FOUR OF THE ACCUSATIONS MADE AGAINST HIM WERE ABSURD AND HE WAS ABLE TO DEFEND HIMSELF SUCCESSFULLY. VASQUEZ NOTED THAT FOUR OF THE ACCUSATIONS HAD TO DO WITH HIS ALLEGED RECEIPT OF AN AUTOMOBILE FROM A NARCOTICS TRAFFICKER AND OTHER FINANCIAL IRREGU- (X)(u)

LEGAT BELIEVES THAT [CIA'S] INFORMATION INDICATING THAT IC WAS PROHIBITED BY PRESIDENT PINOCHET FROM DISCUSSING BOSCH'S CASE WITH ANY AMERICANS. MORE THAN LIKELY REFERS TO VASQUEZ'S REMOVAL FROM SANTIAGO BY TRANSFERRING VASQUEZ, THE CHILEAN GOVERNMENT EFFECTIVELY HAS GUARANTEED THAT THE BOSCH INVESTIGATION WOULD NOT BE DISCUSSED WITH U. S. OFFICERS, SINCE ONLY VASQUEZ, GENERAL BAEZA AND THE DINA DIRECTOR HAD A COMPLETE PICTURE AS TO IC'S INVESTIGATION OF BOSCH. THE IC OFFICIAL REPLACING VASQUEZ HAS VIRTUALLY NO KNOWLEDGE OF REQUEST

MADE TO IC CONCERNING CUBAN EXILE ACTIVITIES AND ACCORDING TO VASQUEZ, THIS IC OFFICER IS COMPLETELY IGNORANT AS TO BOSCH'S ACTIVITIES IN CHILE, SINCE VASQUEZ TRANSMITTED THIS INFORMATION DIRECTLY TO GENERAL BAEZA. ~~(S)~~ (u) ~~(S)~~ (u)

AGAIN, AS PREVIOUSLY NOTED BY THE BUENOS AIRES OFFICE, BOSCH'S ACTIVITIES IN CHILE DURING 1975 ARE OBVIOUSLY EXTREMELY EMBARRASSING TO THE CHILEAN GOVERNMENT AND THE CHILEAN GOVERNMENT IS EXTREMELY RELUCTANT AND WILL BE ADAMANT IN DISCLOSING ANY CONNECTIONS BY BOSCH WITH ANY CHILEAN GOVERNMENT ENTITY.
