SOURCE: A British official service from a regular source, probably reliable, with good contacts in the MRR.

1. On 15 June 1964 a member of the Venezuelan Branch of the Movimiento de Recuperacion Revolucionaria (MRR, Movement for Revolutionary Recovery) claimed that the MRR has no operational base in Venezuela and does not intend to establish one. The MRR maintains an office in the Dominican Republic and is believed to have facilities for using that territory as an occasional staging point for attacks against Cuba. The MRR, however, does not have a permanent base or training camp in the Dominican Republic. The Dominican Government has little interest in supporting Cuban exile activities at the present time.
2. No large-scale exile operations against Cuba by the MRR will take place until after the November 1964 elections in the United States. The MRR claims that this decision is based on the fact that at least six months of preparation will be required before internal conditions in Cuba will be favorable and that the decision does not imply close connivance between the MRR and the United States Administration.
