- 1) Will interview subject regarding his visit to the Cuban Embassy, Mexico, D.F., on the morning of March 7, 1967, prior to departure for Miami.
- 2) Subject on March 6, 1967, remarked that he was awaiting money from his ex-wife or mother in Miami in order to pay his \$60 hotel bill and to pay for his transportation to Miami. Subject should be questioned as to how he was able to pay his \$60 hotel bill plus purchase a ticket valued at approximately \$100 with the \$100 he states he was given by the Cuban Embassy on March 5, 1967.
- 3) Will question subject concerning the telegram he received on February 23, 1967, from the Cuban Embassy directing
