Reference is made to your letter dated March 28, 1949 wherein you advise that the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Mad received information indicating that the Central Intelligence Agency desire to place a representa-tive in Ottawa You requested any comments the Bureau might be able to make relative to this matter

As you know, the Bureau, of course, can make no objection to the establishment of such liaison. For your confidential information, information has been received at the Seat of Government reflecting that such a CIA liaison representative will be placed in Canada Within the next few weeks Officials of CIA have confidentially advised the Bureau's liaison section that they readily

recognize that it will take years to build up a close liaison with the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and related organizations They state, however, that they feel such action must be taken in view of CIA's jurisdiction in foreign circles

For your further information, it has been ascertained confidentially that CTA is presently considering one Samuel Herman Horton a former Bureau Agent and now an employee of the Office of Special Operations, CIA, for the position is questioned. Norton thered the Bureau as a Special Agent on January 15, 1940. He was assigned to the Richmond and Cincinnati Offices and was transferred to the Seat of Government on June 28, 1943. He resigned on December 17, 1944, to accept a position with the Office of Strategic Services
