Enclosed for the Bureau are nine copies, and for Miami, one copy, of a letterhead memorandum concerning captioned organization. Also enclosed for the Bureau and Miami are one copy each of a letter dated 12/7/64, from Luva Cuban Express, Miami, Florida, to Wolff International, Inc., Milwaukee, Wis. and a form requesting contributions for Comandos "L". Enclosed for the Bureau is a copy of pamphlet entitled "Cuban Exiles' Right to Fight for Freedom", published by Comandos "L", Miami, Florida.

Enclosed LHM explains above mentioned letter, contribution form and pamphlet, which were furnished to ASAC J. WALLACE LA PRADE on 2/15/65 by JOHN L. SCHUBERT, Central Intelligence Agency, Milwaukee, Wis., who advised they were received from RAYMOND A. WOLFF, President of Wolff International, Inc., 6833 West Fond du lac, Avenue Milwaukee, a cooperative and reliable business man. SCHUBERT stated WOLFF was interested in contributing to Comandos "L" if such contributions were legal.

SCHUBERT was advised that contributions to Comandos "L" could constitute a violation of Title 18, USC, Section 960.

The Bureau is requested to advise whether or not the department has made any determination concerning contributions to Comandos "L" as violations of the Neutrality laws.
