It is requested that you advise this Bureau the specific information concerning subject desired by the Spanish Alto Estado Mayor (AEM). In this regard, it is noted that the Spanish authorities already possess pertinent data concerning subject's background and subversive activities (S) (U)

(U) (S) AEM. NOTE: Subject has been employed at the United Nations in various positions for a number of years. He is a SI subject and last report from New York dated 8/19/60 did not indicate the extent of his duties. CIA in its letter furnished data concerning subject which it received from CIA. We have previously been in possession of these data. CIA indicated it was interested in learning if subject's position at the UN dealt with the Cong/o. CIA also indicated it would appreciate receipt of any Bureau information on subject that could be passed by CIA to the AEM. Upon receipt of data from CIA as to what is desired to be passed, a decision will be made as to whether CIA or our Legat, Madrid, should pass the information. (S)
