The referenced memorandum further indicated that subject had been in contact with Valeriy Kostikov, Soviet Embassy, Mexico City, and that Kostikov had been tentatively identified as being with the department in KG3 which handles sabotage and assassinations. The Liaison Agent was instructed to obtain from CIA the nature and extent of the Agency's coverage of the Sovict and Cuban Embassies in Mexico and [5] also to inquire concerning the existence of similar coverage on other embassies. The Agent was also requested to check with CIA concerning any additional information pertaining to Kostikov's connection with e KGB Department described above. The following information was Lurnished to the Liaison Agent on 11/27/63 by Birch O'Neal, CIA. BEVIEWED BY FBIJJEK TASK FORCE RELEASE IN PART 3 TOTAL DENIAL CIA does not have coverage on the installations of other countries in Mexico City. Any such coverage could only be initiated for a special case. With regard to Kostikov's connection with the 13th Department of the KGB, which handles saboungs and assassinations, CIA's infirmation is based on data developed both by the Bureau and CIA.
