CUBAN EXILE LEADER OFFENDED BY GUATEMALAN OFFICIAL

Dr. MIRO CARDONA((A)) and Dr. VARONA((B)) visited me today in order to report the conversation that MIRO had with General BONILLA((C)) in Miami.

MIRO complained that BONILLA had humiliated him and treated him disrespectfully. He told me he was willing to talk with any Cuban leader, except former BATISTA men like MUJAL((D)).

He urged me to communicate with you, so that there would be no misunderstandings, since he respects, admires and is grateful to you.

I noted that he was worried but, at the same time, annoyed.

- ((A)) JOSE MIRO CARDONA, head of Cuban Government-in-exile.
- ((B)) MANUEL ANTONIO VARONA, Cuban exile leader.
- ((C)) Guatemalan Consul in Miami, reported to have approached Cuban JULIO GARCERAN with regard to setting up Government-in-exile.
- ((D)) EUSEBIO MUJAL BARNIOL, former Cuban labor leader now in Miami.
