ReBulet 8/17/61, and report of SA THOMAS J. GREEN, dated 7/25/61, at Chicago captioned "PHILLIP JAMES MAINER, Aka. Sam Spardo, UFAP - BURGLARY; SSA, 1948" Bufile 88-17865.

Page 15 of referenced report reflects PHILLIP MAINER using alias of SAM SPARDO stayed at Oaks Motel, Calumet City, Illinois, from 7/14/61, until his arrest by Bureau agents, 7/19/61.

The 1961 Pontiac, Ohio license K415P in which car MAINER arrived in Illinois, according to PCI LEONARD MIRESO of the Indianapolis Division (Furnished to SA JAMES E. DAYLE, Indianapolis Division, 8/18/61) was observed by Bureau Agents 7/17/61, at the Oaks Motel.

Records of the Chicago Police Department, Bureau of Records and Communications, checked 8/21/61, by SA THOMAS J. GREEN reflect MAINER was arrested 7/25/61, by the Chicago Police Department, based on a fugitive warrant from the State of Georgia and released on bond 7/25/61.

No record of arrest for 7/17/61, was located for MAINER.
