(S) Bureau Source [6] in communication classified "Top Secret" advised that on 6/7/62 the Cuban Foreign Ministry (TS) advised the Czechoslovakian Embassy that a visa had been granted to a George Spellmeyer, the owner of a United States fishing vessel known as "Teresa and Julia." Bureau Source [5] advised that Spellmeyer was possibly identical with a George C. Speelmeyer who is listed in the New York City telephone directory. PERSA letter 2/27/98, ndc

In referring to the above matter Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) furnished the name of the fishing vessel as "Teresa y Julia." (S) (u)

CIA on 6/14/62 advised it had received sensitive information indicating that the above-mentioned fishing vessel was leaving Havana for the Isle of Pines where a Cuban prison is located. CIA pointed out that it would appear most unusual that a fishing vessel owned by a U. S. citizen would be involved in such activities. (S) (u)

The foregoing information should not be incorporated in reports prepared for dissemination.

Recipient offices will check with Coast Guard representatives locally for any information they may have concerning the subject and above-mentioned fishing vessel. Under no circumstances should the reason for our inquiry or the fact that we have knowledge of the afore-mentioned information be furnished these agencies or to any individual contacted in this matter. If identified, recipient offices will determine the background of subject and the nature and extent of his involvement in Cuban activities. New York in addition will identify George C. Speelmeyer and determine whether he is the owner of the fishing vessel in question and whether he has any connections with Cuban matters.
