President JOHN F. KENNEDY fell in the performance of his distinguished duties in the service of the most noble causes. He was a remarkable promoter of the friendship which unites peoples in devotion to and the defense of liberty, in their will for co-operation and peace, and in the pursuit of their joint aims. In the belief that history will pay him this homage, I beg you, Mr. President, to accept the deeply felt condolences which I offer in the name of the Provisional Government and in my own name and to extend them to the United States Government and the American people, with whom we have a profound feeling of solidarity in this tragedy.
