SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD

On 1/13/64, MEX-18 and MEX-19 orally advised the writer that on that date ELIZABETH MORA had told them of a conversation which she had held with TERESA PROENZA, the Cultural Attache of the Cuban Embassy.

According to MORA, TERESA PROENZA had told her that OSWALD walked in "cold" to the Cuban Embassy and the first person he talked to was TERESA. She does not speak English, however, and therefore she turned him over to the nearest person (not identified by MORA) wh was higher in rank and who spoke English. TERESA PROENZA claimed that the purpose of OSWALD's visit to the Cuban Embassy was to obtain a visa to go to Russia. The informants could obtain no information from MORA why OSWALD would have gone to the Cuban Embassy which is difficult to find rather than going straight to the Soviet Embassy which is much easier to locate.
