Reference Eddy to Evans memo dated 11-27-63 disclosing subject called Bureau from Montreal, Canada, with information concerning a letter he and a friend found written in German. Subject advised he thought the letter might have some connection with the assassination of the President, and the name Rubenstein was mentioned. He said the letter was currently in possession of his friend, who was attempting to decipher it. *(u)*

Moss Innes, Legal Attache, Ottawa, who is presently in Washington, D. C., was advised of the above facts at 8:05 P.M., instant date. Innes advised that he would contact the RCMP in Montreal and have them obtain all information with respect to the letter and furnish same to the Bureau as soon as obtained. *(u)*

Moss Innes, Legat Ottawa, advised at 10:15 P.M. this date that the Royal Canadian Mounted Police had spoken to Letemdre and that the Royal Canadian Mounted Police are bringing the letter to Innes in the morning after it has been translated from German. The letter was signed by an individual by the name of Schoeters, who is currently in jail in Canada for participating in political activities against the government. Innes believes that this is a crank letter and has no bearing on the assassination. He will contact the Bureau in the A.M., 11-28-63 concerning this matter. *(u)*
