The Mexico City letter and letterhead memo both dated 1-10-64, concerning information furnished by Elizabeth Catlett concerning subject.

One copy of rolet and one copy of ro memo are enclosed for the information of Mexico.

Enclosed for New York are 2 copies of rolet and 2 copies of ro memo. New York should furnish a brief descriptive characterization of Mary Louisa Gonzales who appears to be the person mentioned by Kora and referred to particularly in paragraph 4, page 2, of ro memo.

Although Kora's information should be furnished to CIA and the President's Commission at the earliest possible time, the memo is not being disseminated at this time because of unresolved questions raised by it. As you point out on the first page of rolet, 105-18 and 105-19 will be with Kora when she returns from the illness she has had since 1-8-64, possibly for a 2- or 3-day period, and they should obtain from her all aspects of her knowledge regarding subject. It is expected that many of the questions raised by ro memo will be resolved by these 2 informants. Some of these questions are set out below:

When your sources furnishing information about the CP of Mexico, do you have confirmation of Kora's information set out in paragraph 2, page 1, of ro memo that the CP of Mexico was interested in obtaining all information regarding subject's Mexican trip? Is there any indication steps have been taken by the CP of Mexico to obtain this information? Also, what other information have you received, if any, that the CP of Mexico was interested in obtaining information as to how much American authorities knew about subject's trip to Mexico?

In paragraph 3, page 1, of re name Eric reportedly spoke of subject's "activities before his trip to the Soviet Union." In paragraph 5, page 1, she spoke of his activities in New Orleans before he went to Russia. Subject left New Orleans in September, 1962, for Russia after spending a very short period of time there. No information has been developed that he engaged in any subversive activities while in New Orleans at that time. It is possible that although Eric spoke of Oswald's activities before he went to Russia, that what she meant was, before he went to Mexico. This point should be clarified. U

In paragraph 2, page 2, of re name the question arises as to whether it was Eric, Eric's source or the Americans in Russia who believed that subject could not have undertaken singly to assassinate President Kennedy. U

Although Eric is a Mexican citizen, it is possible she will have to be interviewed eventually. Underlying all the information she furnished as set out in re name, lies the question whether she met with subject while he was in Mexico. U

Your continuing investigation of Eric's knowledge of subject should aim at answering the above questions and your next memo should contain those answers. You should make your recommendations after [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have been with Eric as to any additional investigative steps which should be taken. Continue to pursue your investigation vigorously. (S) (u) U

It is noted in memo to classified "Secret." When this memo is disseminated to the Committee questions may be asked about this classification and, therefore, you should in your next communication to the Bureau relating to Eric, fully detail your reasons for this classification. The Bureau is not questioning the correctness of the classification but merely asking that you set forth fully your reasons for it. U

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
