Soviet Ambassador Dobrynin contacted Ambassador at Large Llewelyn Thompson of the State Department. Dobrynin stated that as regards the business of the Oswald case he hoped they would give the documents which they spoke of on Monday or Tuesday. It is known that the Presidents' Commission had previously indicated they would attempt to get additional data on Oswald in the Soviet Union through the State Department. Dobrynin also stated that he had been asked to inquire again if there was anything new about the Ivanov case because as he understands it they are prepared to let free those students "Linderman or Landerman," he cannot remember the exact name of the individual, in the event Ivanov is also set free. Dobrynin is referring to Egor A. Ivanov, who was arrested in New Jersey on October 29, 1963, for espionage conspiracy. Thompson stated that he does not have an answer but he guessed that they do not have much chance to prevent the trial but that they do have a good chance, he thinks, whether or not he is convicted, to let him loose afterwards and this is what he is working on. was good news (S) (W) Classified by 5/70 H&B GAT
