Confirming information furnished by re telephone call, the following is set forth: U

England
At 5:40 P.M. 11/29/63 an individual telephonically contacted the Security Office, U.S. Embassy, London. The man identified himself as HASSAN, residing at 7 Florence Road, N. 4, London. The man said, "we have information that the United Arab Republic was behind President Kennedy's death." When asked who "we" was, he said "Me and my family." The man was asked to come to the Embassy but refused to and said he should be contacted at the address he gave. U

The foregoing information was furnished to Col. MALCOLM CUMMING, British Security Service, MI-5, with the request that HASSAN be immediately located and interviewed concerning this matter. Col. CUMMING said that he would order same done immediately. The Bureau will be kept advised concerning this *(u)*

At 5:47 PM 11/29/63 a man, who did not identify himself, telephonically contacted the Security Office, American Embassy, London. He asked the secretary if she was in a position to take some information and then said to her, "Take this down, I haven't time. I am going to go very fast and repeat it only once." He then said, "I just arrived from New York today. Well, it doesn't really matter what my name is, does it?" He then continued, "The people that had RUBY killed (he actually said "Ruby killed" although the secretary assumed he meant "had Ruby to kill") are the same people that directed (some organization or somebody of which the secretary couldn't catch the name) to

relax their observations. A man named Hart or Hartis in that city. In other words, it's an internal (the secretary couldn't recall the noun he used)." The Security Officer, Mr. KEMP, then arrived in his office, spoke to the man and asked him to repeat his story. The man repeated his story again so rapidly that no clearer version could be obtained. When asked by Mr. KEMP for further details about himself, the man refused and said "I have to hang up." Mr. KEMP observed that the man sounded like an Englishman. He talked at a fast clip, slightly excited but in a coherent strong voice. U

The Executive Assistant to the Ambassador, Mr. ALFRED WELLS, by letter dated 11/29/63, acknowledged Mrs. PEAKER's letter and advised her that her letter has been passed on to the FBI. U

In addition to the foregoing, there is enclosed an Autostat copy of a letter dated 11/29/63 signed K. WALEGORA, addressed to Asst. Legat McCRAY. The writer puts forth a theory that the assassination of the President was organized by the Soviet Secret Service. This individual is known to this office and to Special Branch, New Scotland Yard, as a mentally unstable chronic complainer, whose real name is KAZIMIERZ WINCENY WALEGORA, born 3/4/15 in Poland. He is a disbarred attorney and came to England as a war-time refugee. He has contacted the U.S. Embassy and the police on numerous occasions in the past regarding his "problems." X(u)
