ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

REMYAIRTEL DECEMBER 2 RE HASSAN WHO HAD SAID UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC BEHIND PRESIDENTS DEATH. MI-5 HAS IDENTIFIED HASSAN AS YAKLA ZAKARIA HASSAN, IN UNITED KINGDOM SINCE 1953. IN INTERVIEW HASSAN STATED HE MET TEWFIQ SHAWKI EL-HADIDI TWO YEARS AGO IN LONDON. HE THOUGHT TEWFIQ HAD SOME CONNECTION WITH UAR GOVERNMENT. ON NOVEMBER 28 TEWFIQ VISITED HASSAN. TEWFIQ BECAME DRUNK, MADE OFFENSIVE REMARKS ABOUT AMERICA AND PRESIDENT KENNEDY, PULLED A GUN FROM HIS JACKET AND STATED, "WE HAVE COMPLETED OUR WORK IN AMERICA, NOW WE SHALL BE RETURNING TO EGYPT."

FURTHER INVESTIGATION REVEALS TEWFIQ BELIEVED TO BE CAPTAIN IN EGYPTIAN ARMY AND TO BE NOW WORKING AS INTELLIGENCE OFFICER. IS BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN IN UNITED STATES RECENTLY. NO FURTHER DETAILS AVAILABLE. MI-5 WILL MAKE FURTHER INVESTIGATION IF BUREAU DESIRES.
