Dear Mr. Innes:

A delicate and reliable source has reported to us that members of the Cuban diplomatic mission in Ottawa greeted the news of President KENNEDY's death with jubilation.

2. The Cuban Embassy received instructions from the Cuban Foreign Minister Raul ROA to abide by protocol rulings in force and to take part in mourning for President KENNEDY only if official observations of mourning were decreed by the Canadian Government and the Diplomatic Corps. Cuban representatives in Canada were also instructed to abide by the declaration delivered by Cuban Ambassador IECHUGA at the United Nations, in which he announced that "Cuba had received the news of the tragic death of President KENNEDY with profound displeasure".
