*This report that Cuban officials in Ottawa were jubilant over President Kennedy's death was passed to us by RCMP with the restriction that it not be disseminated outside the FBI without clearing with RCMP. Since such a reaction could be expected from Castro's diplomats, we are not attempting to obtain RCMP clearance to further disseminate.*

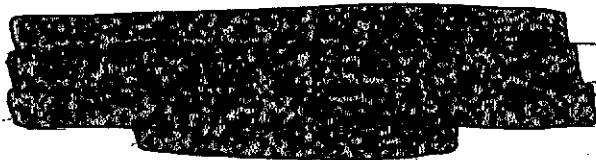

Dear Mr. Innes:

A delicate and reliable source has reported to us that members of the Cuban diplomatic mission in Ottawa greeted the news of President KENNEDY's death with jubilation.

2. The Cuban Embassy received instructions from the Cuban Foreign Minister Raul ROA to abide by protocol rulings in force and to take part in mourning for President KENNEDY only if official observations of mourning were decreed by the Canadian Government and the Diplomatic Corps. Cuban representatives in Canada were also instructed to abide by the declaration delivered by Cuban Ambassador LECHUGA at the United Nations, in which he announced that "Cuba had received the news of the tragic death of President KENNEDY with profound displeasure".

3. We are forwarding this for your information. Please ensure protection for our source.
