HARVEY LEE OSWALD-INTERNAL SECURITY-R AND CUBA. REBULET TO CIA SEPTEMBER 30 ENTITLED RICHARD THOMAS GIBSON, IS-CUBA, AND BERN LET OCTOBER 11 ENTITLED AFRICAN REVOLUTION, RA-AFRICA.

SWISS FEDERAL POLICE, REFERRING TO PREVIOUS CORRESPONDENCE WITH LEGAT PARIS, NUMBER S-299 DATED JUNE 16, 1960; S-414 DATED JULY 28, 1961; AND THEIR REPLIES NUMBER 16 OF SEPTEMBER 29 AND NUMBER 19 OF OCTOBER 20, BOTH 1960, STATED THEY HAD IN VIEW OF RECENT TRAGEDY AGAIN CONTACTED ALBERT SCHWEITZER COLLEGE AT CHURWALDEN FOR POSSIBLE ADDITIONAL INFO AND ASCERTAINED THAT ALL CORRESPONDENCE EXCHANGED BY COLLEGE WITH OSWALD AND HIS MOTHER FORWARDED IN MARCH 1961 TO JIM WRIGHT, MEMBER OF CONGRESS, WASHINGTON, D.C. AT REQUEST OF OSWALD'S MOTHER. IN ADDITION, SWISS FEDERAL POLICE INFORMED THAT DELICATE SOURCE FURNISHED CONVERSATION IN FRENCH BETWEEN UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL AND RICHARD THOMAS GIBSON (BUFILE 105-93072) AT LAUSANNE, SWITZERLAND, AS FOLLOWS: (S) (U)
