ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS

On January 14, 1968, a confidential source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that Mrs. Kenneth Porter, also known as Mrs. Marina Porter of Dallas, Texas, who is apparently the widow of Lee Harvey Oswald, was in contact with her father, Aleksandr Ivanovich Medvedev, Apartment 43, Obvodnoy Kanal 80, Leningrad, USSR. Contact concerned mutual well-being and Mrs. Porter invited her father to visit her in the United States and indicated she would pay all expenses for his visit. Her father indicated he would like to come to the United States and would endeavor to obtain the necessary papers for the visit.

It is noted that when she testified before the Warren Commission, Mrs. Marina Oswald stated Aleksandr Ivanovich Medvedev was her stepfather. She stated she never knew her real father.
