Enclosed is a memorandum entitled "Lee Harvey Oswald, Internal Security - Russia - Cuba," dated January 20, 1964, which sets forth details of a contact between Mark Lane, the attorney hired by Marguerite Oswald, the mother of Lee Harvey Oswald, and Zygmunt Broniarek, Washington, D. C., correspondent for "Trybuna Ludu," a Polish daily newspaper and the official organ of the Polish United Workers (Communist) Party. During this contact, Zygmunt Broniarek supported the view of Mark Lane in an article to his newspaper that someone other than Lee Harvey Oswald was responsible for the death of President John Kennedy.
