It was ascertained that the Yugoslavs would have a ship leaving the US for Belgrade about the 10th of September, 1964. It was expected that LJUBOMIR LJUBIC, Consul of the Yugoslav Consulate, would be returning to Yugoslavia on the ship of September 10th.

ROBERT 0. BLAKE of US Mission was in contact with DRAGAN BERNARDIC and they agreed to meet each other on Friday evening. BERNARDIC indicated that he was sorry to hear that BLAKE was leaving. BLAKE said that he will go to California first to visit his parents. BERNARDIC told BLAKE that he would be going to Belgrade shortly for a period of 20 days. (The trip to Belgrade by BERNARDIC is in connection with the recall of BERNARDIC FOR consultations in the Co-ordination Department from Information as furnished by CIA).
