The 40 pages enclosed herewith, when Enserted among the appropriate pages in your classified letterhead, postitute the unclassified version furnished to the President's mission. Note in this regard that the information set forth of pages 122 through and including 127 of your classified letterad has been condensed into pages 122 through and including 124 in the unclassified version. This has necessitated remumbering the pages in the original draft beginning with page 128. The unclassified version is now 178 pages in length as opposed to the 181-page classified version. UNote that on page 304 of the Commission's summary report he Commission states in part as follows, "...the Government of xico initiated a therough investigation to uncover as much information as possible on Gesald's trip. Representatives of U. S. agencies worked in close limison with the Mexican law enforcement authorities." introductory statement coincides with aforementioned statement of the Commission and is designed to emphasize the liaison capacity of U.S. representatives in Mexico. You will note that the Eureau did not delete all references to the T symbol sources in the unclassified version for in Eureau's opinion to do so and to merely report results of investigation in a Eureau letterhead without reference to various sources would create the impression that Eureau representatives, in fact, conducted the reported investigation. Note, however, that all references in your classified version to the first confidential source abroad have either been deleted or attributed to T-17, who is identified in your 5/18 letter transmitting the summary. In addition, all references to T symbol sources, who obviously were members of the Embassy staff, have been deleted. The latter area includes reporting of results of interviews of people who called at the Embassy to volunteer information. X(M)

In preparing the unclassified version, the Bureau has endeavored to include therein results of all investigation, specifically requested by the Commission, and any investigation which was touched upon in the Commissions summary report. Accordingly, it was not possible to completely delete all of the information concerning Charles Small. The information concerning Small furnished by AMM 18 and 19 face been further condensed in the unclassified version and dates then information was furnished by sources have been deleted.

In view of the extensive investigation conducted into the allegations of Gutlerrez Valencia and in light of the tenuous nature of his claims, Bureau deemed it inadvisable to delete his identity. ${\cal U}$

In accordance with your suggestions, the names of most of the Hexican Government officials who provided information have been either deleted or protected by informant symbol in the unclassified version $\mathcal{S}(u)$

If after review of the unclassified letterhead you desire to prepare your contacts in the Hexican Covernment for its publication, you are authorized to do so. It is suggested in this regard that you point to the statement of the Fresident's Commission outlined above and stress to your contacts that the excellent investigative results obtained in connection with the matter at hand, which was of world-wide importance, should reflect favorably upon the Hexican Government.
