

EITHER THE FBI OR JUSTICE DEPARTMENT. HE SAID MADIGAN TOLD HIM. IT WAS NOT NECESSARY TO HAVE A RELEASE FROM THE FBI OR JUSTICE AND THAT THEY HAD RECENTLY INTERVIEWED SA C. JORDAN NAYLOR, SA EARL PETERSEN AND SA (FNU) OLSEN. HE SAID HE BELIEVES MADIGAN ALSO STATED THEY HAD INTERVIEWED FORMER SAC REX I. SHRODER AND SAC CLARK F. BROWN (NOTE THEY HAVE NOT INTERVIEWED BROWN NOR HAS BROWN BEEN CONTACTED BY THEM). HE ALSO STATED MADIGAN SAID HE WOULD PREFER THAT CHRISTENSEN APPEAR ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS BUT THAT THEY DID HAVE SUBPOENA POWER AND WOULD USE IT IF
