2. We have at last run John Anthony RAWLES to earth. He was born on 6th October, 1945 and is now resident at 21 Lower Rock Gardens, Brighton, following his discharge from the Royal Navy on medical grounds (asthma). He served in the Navy as a cook and he is currently employed as a cook in a Brighton guest-house. RAWLES claims that he became acquainted with an American subject, Thomas HARVEY, in Paris in September 1963. RAWLES was interviewed on 15th June, 1965 and I attach a copy of his statement then recorded, which he signed, for your information.

3. RAWLES has voluntarily loaned us the "Book of Remembrance" referred to in his statement as having been given him by HARVEY. As RAWLES has been promised that this book would be returned to him, I should be grateful if you would let me have it back at your early convenience.
