TRAPNELL alleging a plot by Cuban refugees as of 5/63 or 6/63, to kill Attorney General ROBERT KENNEDY. Investigation was discontinued in view of TRAPNELL's mental condition, after extensive investigation had failed to identify FUENTES or any other subject allegedly involved.

In view of past experience with information received from TRAPNELL, and the fact that to date no evidence that LEE HARVEY OSWALD has been in Miami was developed, no investigation based on the Baltimore airtel of 11/23/63 is being conducted.

regard to Cuba. This report further reflected that BUCHANAN, in addition to being a newspaper writer, was getting involved personally in revolutionary activities pertaining to Haiti and Cuba.

Miami file 47-4019, Bufile 47-48702, pertains to a fugitive investigation on JERRY BUCHANAN, FBI #148937D, the brother of JAMES BUCHANAN. That case involved the use of U.S. Army identification in the name JESSE L. MURPHY by JERRY BUCHANAN in cashing three stolen checks at Miami. That file reflects the brother of JERRY BUCHANAN as JAMES CHARLES BUCHANAN, and the parents as JAMES and MARY BUCHANAN, 3543 Northwest 33rd Street, Miami. File

Miami file 2-317, Bufile 2-1712, also pertains to JERRY BUCHANAN, FBI #148937D, and this case was based on recruiting activities by JERRY BUCHANAN for the Anti-Communist International Brigade of FRANK FIORINI. The same file reflects JERRY BUCHANAN was sent to the Florida State Penitentiary as of 7/28/61 for three years as a Parole Violator from a forgery conviction.
