St. Petersburg
December 20, 1963

Report of a meeting held at the home of BILL HENDRIX, 2810 North Sunnordale Rd., Clearwater, Fla., on December 13, 1963.

Present were BILL HENDRIX, JANE DAVIS, EUGENE DOMINIQUE and TONNY TOMPHINS. During the evening, about 9:30, Mrs. HENDRIX came on in. She had been at the Peggy's Bayou Oyster place.

Discussion and talk was general and no plans for action were talked about.

TOMPHINS got on the subject of POTITO. He says that Dr. HERAGIN still sees POTITO, but that he, HERAGIN, realizes POTITO is up to no good. They feel that the only cause POTITO is espousing is POTITO. TOMPHINS claims that a couple of his supporters were so sold on POTITO's claim of danger to the nation from atomic radiation, fall-out or something, and the need for a survival area, that they not only gave him large sums of money to equip this place he is supposed to have, they also gave him \$17,000 to go to Jacksonville and buy gold and silver for them, this to be buried at the survival area. According to TOMPHINS, POTITO claims to have done this for them, but HERAGIN says the couple - name STEPHENS or STEVENS - admit that POTITO has never taken them to the survival area - in fact, that they do not know where it is.

There was a great deal of discussion about POTITO's past; where he had been and what he had been doing. Mrs. DAVIS mentioned that she knew a man who had seen pictures of POTITO and believed he remembered him from Roxbury, Mass., ten or fifteen years ago, where he had been in some sort of trouble. She stated that she is trying to find out more about this.
