Dear Sir:

With reference to your telex dated 14 January 1976 concerning the Warren Commission Documents and the release of information to the public on Lee Harvey OSWALD,

Legat Ottawa office was advised that

2. R.C.M.P. Security Service data forwarded to the Bureau retains all designated security classification and is not to be disseminated outside the Bureau.

3. Intelligence material forwarded to, or received from the Bureau, is protected in Canada by the Canadian Government's Cabinet Directive 46. ~~Our~~ intelligence material is considered an "exempted record" by this Directive, which means a public record:

- (a) that contains information the release of which
 - (i) would be contrary to law,
 - (ii) is restricted pursuant to an agreement made between the Government of Canada and any other government,
 - (iii) might be considered by any government to be a breach of faith on the part of the Government of Canada,
 - (iv) might embarrass the Government of Canada in its relations with any other government,
 - or
 - (v) might violate the right of privacy of any individual;

(b) that relates to security and intelligence.
