BU 248-S furnished the following:

"March 11, 1964

"On March 6, 1964, a Buffalo Branch Workers World Party meeting was held at 831 Main Street, Buffalo, N.Y. Jeanette Merrill was Chairman of the meeting. There was no Recording Secretary; however, Ernie Weissman made a financial report and reported that a balance of \$301.82 was on hand at the end of February, 1964.

"Bob Sterling spoke concerning the handling of arrangements for the Mark Lane meeting by the Committee to Hear Mark Lane. He said that the committee of students held meetings February 15 and 22, 1964. The February 22, 1964, meeting was held at the residence of Mary Ann and Ernie Weissman. He said the group originally rented a room at the Lafayette Hotel for the purpose of holding the meeting there, but later decided against it and cancelled the reservation. They then reserved a room at the Buffalo Hotel intending to have the meeting there; however, the hotel cancelled the reservation, and it was necessary to obtain the hall at the Unitarian Church, Elmwood and Ferry.
