On November 26, 1963, Agent HANON CRUZCO A., of the State Judicial Police, Mericali, Baja California, Mexico, advised he had learned unofficially through his office that during the late President KENNEDY's visit to Mexico in 1962, Secret Police of Mexico City arrested an American when they had received information was planning an assassination of KENNEDY in Mexico.

CRUZCO said he did not learn the name of the alleged American, but expressed a belief this information would be made available by the Mexican Secret Police, Mexico City, if it is not already in the possession of the United States authorities.
