MICHAEL TURNER, WTOP News, to R. KRYSOSIK, asked for the names of the persons from Poland coming to the president's funeral and the time of their arrival. KRYSOSIK told him that STANISLAW KULCZYNSKI, the Vice Pres. of the Council of State is heading the delegation and that PIOTR JAROSIEWICZ, the deputy prime minister is the other member coming. They arrive on Scand. Airlines in New York at 5:35pm today and at Washington National Airport on Eastern Airlines flight 19 (probably meant 119) at 8:56pm. KRYSOSIK will advise TURNER if there are any changes. JJP

HERBERT MALIN, State Dept., (to R. KRYSOSIK) advised that State Dept. had requested that guards be posted ~~xxxx~~ at all Socialist country missions in Chicago and New York because of strong intelligence information that has been received. He indicated that has nothing to do with the personnel of the missions. The State Dept. has requested that the men be changed so that there will be no one in uniform in front of these places-only plainclothesmen.

R. KRYSOSIK to H. MALIN UDS. (RK) says that since the Embassy nor the Consul Office in Chicago requested the police guard, the Poles feel that the Chicago newspaper should be asked to make a retraction or correction. Malin asked if they had heard from KITA or anyone. No. Malin asks if they know if only plainclothesman is there now. No, they just feel the statement should be corrected. Malin says that almost all of USDS personnel are some place or another greeting the incoming officials of foreign nations, that it would be virtually impossible to do anything today, but that first thing tomorrow he will bring it to the attention of those who handle press matters, for their consideration. OK, yhanks much.
