Sir:

Is Navy going to allow families of the Pacific Northwest to be turned into ATOMIC DUST by taking a chance on a NUCLEAR HOLOCAUST? Somewhere along the beaches of Washington or Oregon is a MARK 46 TORPEDO, ARMED WITH A NUCLEAR WARHEAD.

Stop misleading the people, "WARNING, A FLARE POT AND etc. MAY BE ON THE BEACHES. DON'T TOUCH, BUT CALL NAVY." This NUCLEAR WARHEAD is triggered by a MAGNETIC IMPULSE DETONATOR. Any piece of metal, such as a shovel can trigger this WARHEAD.

The MARK46 is built in Southern California and airlifted to the NAVAL TORPEDO TEST STATION. KEYPORT, WASHINGTON. IT IS THEN TESTED IN THE WATERS OF THE NORTH WEST.
