The above information is being set forth in the administrative section in view of its negative nature and the fact that inclusion in the details of a disseminated report might reveal Bureau activity in a foreign country.

Full details concerning the flight of CHARLES WILLIAM HORMEL to Cayman Island are contained in the above referenced report of SA GEORGE E. DAVIS, JR.
