Interview:

Mr. Dalzell has previously been interviewed by L.J. Delsa and Bob Buras.

However, I reinterviewed him again briefly. He states that before the Bay of Pigs he was employed as a private investigator for a firm under the name of Jack Martin, Neubrugh and Dalzell. They did a lot of routine private investigator work such as divorce cases and things of that nature.

He further states that he started an organization called the FDC (Friends of Democratic Cuba) and that Guy Banister was asked to be on their Board of Directors along with an Alfred, the last name is spelled, Chittendon, and the reason for this was that he wanted to make sure that any monies collected were put to their proper use. He said he used to visit a restaurant, Jack Mancuso, and a bar and grill known as the Katzenjammer, along with Guy Banister.

He also stated that Mr. K, who had an office in the Masonic building and who identified himself as a CIA agent, asked him to furnish information relative to any Cuban communication systems that he was able to uncover. He said that on occasions that he did go into the Masonic building,

couldn't remember the office, but he felt that it was above the offices of the FBI and he did give this Mr. K certain information that he obtained.

He said that he left New Orleans some time in 1962 or 1963 before the assassination. He also stated that there was considerable activity in the area around the Balter Building and 544 Camp Street but he couldn't identify any offices-office that was the center of this activity.

He knew Arcacha Smith as his office was over the FDC office at the Walther Building. He was shown photographs and he identified the following photographs by numbers: 5, 7, 13, 16, 23, 26, (24 was a possible), 8, states he has seen him in the area but doesn't know him.

With regard to Carlos Bringuier, he said Carlos helped them to obtain blood and clothing. For further information, the memo submitted by Delsa and Buras should be reviewed.
