to overthrow the Belista Regime in Cube. Lorenz was also interviewed in 1962 in Florida regarding a white Slave Traffic Act case. She admitted being the Distress of Marcos Perez Jimenes, former president of Venezuela, who fathered her Gaughter. Investigation failed to establish that Lorenz was a victim in the Maite Slave Traffic Act case.

Articles appearing in the "Washington Star" dated June 14, 1976, and in the "New York Daily News" on June 13, 1976, and June 14, 1976, allege that Marita Lorens lived with Fidel Castro in Havana in 1959 and was later recruited by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) to poison Castro. According to the articles, she was contacted by Frank Fiorini, also known as Frank Sturgis, and by Alex Korke, both alleged to be employed by the CIA. She was urged to travel to Cuba for the purpose of killing Castro and she finally agreed to do so. She told reporters that Fiorini furnished her with poison which she was to sprinkle into Castro's coffee. The poison, which was contained in two capsules, was bidden in Lorens's cold cream jar, but when she reached Havana and attempted to remove the capsules, she discovered that the capsules had dissolved, and gendered the poison useless. The

There is no indication in PBI files that Lorens ever advised the FBI about her alleged involvement in the Castro assessination plot, nor is there any indication in the files that she was ever asked to perform a tank on behalf of the FBI in the United States or Cube.

An article in the August 24, 1976, edition of the Mew York Daily Mows, page 30, reported that Senator Schweiker had requested Sustice Department protection of Lorens after she was pistol whipped in her Manhattan spartment in July. Lorens told reporters her attacker later phoned her epartment building and told the superintendent that Lorens would "get what Moselli got" if she did not keep her mouth shut. Arrested and charged with first degree assent. Lorenz was interviewed by Ful Agents on Deptember 1, 1976, regarding John Roselli. She admitted meeting Roselli casually in 1959 and 1960 but denied any recent contact with him, nor would she advance any theory regarding Roselli's death other than the fact that he had broken the code of silonce of the Hafin. Chieppe Paggiano was interviewed by the FSI on September 2, 1976. The stated that he has never not John Roselli and he only knows about Boselli those things he reads in the paper. Faggiane advised the new York Daily News article which quoted him as telling Lorenz's apartment superintendent that Lorenz would "get what Roselli got," was not true.

This letter has been classified confidential because it contains the identity of persons who have furnished information to the FBI on a confidential basis.

GID, in attached letter to the Assistant Attorney General dated September 8, 1976, responded to a request from Assistant Attorney General Thornburgh for information from our files. The September 8 response, based on an indices search using the spelling of Lorenz's name as furnished by Senator Schweiker to the Department of Justice, resulted in no record being located. Investigation in the Roselli Obstruction of Justice case, however, reveals the files upon which this letter is based. September 9, 1976, when the information on Lorenz was located, Mr. Gerald Shur, Criminal Division, Department of Justice, was immediately contacted and advised that information regarding Lorenz would be forthcoming. Shur stated he would attach a note to that effect onto the September 8, 1976 letter so that the Assistant Attorney General would be aware that the information was forthcoming. This letter furnishes the information regarding Lorenz to the Assistant Attorney General
