His legal residence is listed as Largo, Florida. His cover is "none" [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Operational expenses for purchase of information and entertainment are okayed "when authorized"

3. Notification of Establishment of Military Backstop Cover for Hunt dated 20 July 1965. Cover established [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Hunt's resignation was effective 3 Jul 65.

4. Memo from OGC to Chief/Contract Personnel Division says that Hunt is under light cover [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] dated 8/12/65

5. Memo for the record by Thomas Karamessines dated 1 June 67.

" [Hunt] on instructions of the Deputy Director of Plans, and with approval from the DCI and the DDCI, was converted to contract employment and assigned to Spain for a special undertaking on behalf of the DDP. He left for Spain in July 1965 and returned to the U.S. in June 1966 having completed his assignment successfully. If an evaluative comment is needed to cover his work during this period of time he should be rated as "strong".

6. Memo for the Deputy Director for Support from WE division dated 11/8/65 says: "Due to the operational sensitivity of [HUNT'S] assignment, his request for relief on his housing costs was handled by Mr. Thomas Karamessines, ADDP."
