On May 23, 1961, a confidential informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that Hilt Friedman of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency advised Ambassador Avraham Harman, Israeli Ambassador to the United States, that President John F. Kennedy had just sent a message to King Ibn Saud of Saudi Arabia in connection with Israel and Arab relations. According to Friedman, King Saud had called a meeting of the Arab League Council.

The informant advised that the Israeli Ambassador had not had any previous information on this report and efforts were being made by Embassy personnel to verify the report.
