A confidential source advised that the subject was seen playing golf at the Churrubusco Country Club, Mexico City, 7-21-73. He was playing with a group including BOB LERNER, the brother of ALAN JAY LERNER of Broadway reknown. (X) u

Previous information reported in Mexico City letter 11-27-72, indicated that a local architect ROBERTO MORALES, telephone 5-14-15-69, was a friend of subject and was doing work for him. (X) u

It was determined that telephone number 5-14-15-69 is listed to MAX GLUCK, Marsella 70-5. (X) u

The records of the American Embassy, Mexico City, Citizenship Section, show Passport Z154164 was issued 4-21-72 to MAX GLUCK, born 9-19-05, Delaware, sister BERTHA GLUCK, 888 Eighth Avenue, New York. (X) u

Sources indicate that GLUCK and ROBERTO MORALES are fairly well known bachelor decorators who live and work at Marsella 70-5. (X) u

MEX 287 has advised that a pair of reportedly homosexual decorators in Mexico City had done the work on subject's various homes in Mexico and handled other business for him. He was certain that these individuals would not be cooperative with authorities about subject and his activities. (X) u
