## Remarks (By SAC): 17.

It is recommended that this surveillance be maintained for an additional period of <u>ninety days and such will be done UACB</u>, There can be no doubt that the general quality and quantity of information obtained through this source has greatly decreased since its peak three years ago. However, this source does continue to be active to some extent as can be seen through the information set out under number 9. In addition, attention is drawn to the fact that no expense is involved in monitoring this source due to the fact that the same employees who monitor other surveillances on the same subject conveniently and with only nominal additional effort monitor this source. In addition, it should be clearly understood that there does not appear to be any particular risk involving the security of this source, the only risk being that which would be inherent in making an entry to retrieve the microphone.
