From the following conversation, it became known that GOLDSTEIN is presently representing a former Chicago policeman named MAOLA (ph), who was indicted in 1960 during the national elections for vote fraud. When it became known that MAOLA was a policeman, he was subsequently suspended from the Chicago Police Force and his case is presently due to come up before the Civil ~~SERVICE~~ Commission for his release from the force. GOLDSTEIN discusses the situation with MARCY and has requested MARCY to pull as many strings as he can so that this individual can be ^{RE}instated. GOLDSTEIN takes the stand that MAOLA was merely the victim of circumstances, but is being made to bear the entire brunt of this incident.

~~MAOLA~~ requested MARCY to contact the Mayor, leading police officials, and LOU WEXLER, the Assistant Corporation Counsel, under whose direction the case will be tried before the CSC. During the conversation, ANTHONY GIROLAMI, identical to CG 6498-PC, joined the group and was also requested to do his part on behalf of MAOLA. GOLDSTEIN continued that MAOLA has been out of work for 15 months and has been having difficulty gaining employment when the reasons for his unemployment become known. It is pointed out that the violations occurred in the 28th Ward, of which GIROLAMI was alderman at the time of the occurrence. GOLDSTEIN claims that MAOLA told him that GIROLAMI had instructed him to do "it" which GIROLAMI disclaims heatedly.

MARCY's first statement concerning his actions in the matter will be to have the case postponed for a minimum of two months so that they will have more time to work on the matter.

During the afternoon of 5/14/63, Lieutenant LOUIS MUELLER and Officer JOHN AURIEMMA, License Officers of the Chicago Police Department, were in contact with PAT MARCY. Lt. MUELLER explained that he is investigating an application for a liquor license made by Austin Liquors. It is noted that Austin Liquors is owned by the FILICHO family and that there are numerous Austin Liquor Stores located throughout the Chicago area. One of the members of the FILICHO family is BEN FILICHO, who testified as a defense witness for TONY ACCARDO during ACCARDO's trial in the fall of 1960.

Lt. MUELLER explained to MARCY that there is no way that he can grant, legally, the application for a license, due
