Mr. STANLEY R. MOIR, Assistant Commissioner of Crime, Bahamas Police Force, furnished Miami information concerning NICKY MANCUSO, 1620 South Cicero Avenue, Chicago, who has been observed as a frequent visitor at the gambling casinos in Freeport, Grand Bahama.

Miami indices reveal that on 1/29/64, CHARLES SAPP, Intelligence Unit, Miami PD, reported that one NICHOLAS MANCUSO, aka. Nick, and who was reported to be a former associate of AL CAPONE, was reported to have been in the W. Palm Beach area. The report described MANCUSO as a white male, age 63, 5' 9", having a mole on his cheek. The Chicago Office was requested to check indices and furnish Miami with identifying data on MANCUSO.

The Chicago Office has advised that there appears to be a possibility that the person using the name NICKY MANCUSO might possibly be identical with SAM GIANCANA, former Chicago La Cosa Nostra (LCN) leader, who has been self-exiled from Chicago. Chicago advised that GIANCANA in 1958 traveled to Los Angeles with ANTHONY J. ACCARDO, and on this occasion, information was developed which indicated that GIANCANA used the alias MIKE MANCUSO. ✓

On 4/25/68, a letter was submitted to Commissioner MOIR enclosing a photograph of SAM GIANCANA, and descriptive data on the Chicago LCN leader. A request has been made that Commissioner MOIR exhibit this photograph and make inquiries to determine whether or not the NICKY MANCUSO identified at Freeport is in fact SAM GIANCANA. (u)
