DORSETT was the leader of the group and mentioned Patrolmen J. M. STEVENSON, EDMONDSON, and COLE as being known members of this group. He also stated there was an insurance salesman by the name of SAM LUCARIELLO, 3954 Garrison who was a member of the group.
