Re: ALBERT MEADOWS, aka. IGA (DL 162-109)

On 4/17/62, toll charges to the residence phones of MEADOWS, his number one associate BILLY RAY GRIMES, and tolls charged to his girl friend HELEN CARTER's phone, were obtained from Southwestern Bell Telephone Co., Dallas.

On 4/20/62, MEADOWS' automobile was observed parked behind the residence of GRIMES on South Lancaster Road, Dallas.

On 4/20/62 it was ascertained that GRIMES and his girl friend JANICE CHRISTAKIS had moved from her apartment, No. 103, 1700 Mignon, during March 1962. The landlady advised that CHRISTAKIS never left the apartment and that her only visitor was a young woman with two small children. A description of this visitor matches that of HELEN CARTER. The landlady also advised that when they left it was determined that they had had two phones in the apartment.

On 4/20/62, DL-141-PCI advised SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING that he had heard MEADOWS was now running a gambling operation in either Alabama or Georgia for a man, identity unknown, who had wanted someone to take over this operation for him as this person had made a fortune through this gambling operation. The informant stated he would attempt to determine further details and advised SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING.

The above information was orally furnished to LT. JACK REVILL and DEP. MORGAN on 4/20/62.

Re: MARION ROBERT RAIF, aka. AR (DL 92-39)

On 4/19/62, the Little Rock Office advised that UFAP - Burglary process had been obtained for RAIF and his associates JAMES BENNETT WAAGE, JOHN OSCAR LUCK, RONALD EDWARD SMITH and JOHN B. NOBLE in connection with the burglary of a Little Rock store on 4/16/62 (DL 87-10,126). Subsequently RAIF, LUCK and SMITH were apprehended 4/19/62 by Bureau Agents in the Atlanta, Ga. area. WAAGE and NOBLE are still Bureau fugitives.
