Informant stated NORRIS claims to have thirty-two bars of gold for sale, but informant does not know if this is true.

2. Maintain contact with Departmental Attorney KEITH E. GISLESON, New Orleans regarding possibility of subpoenaing PROVENZANO and LEGAN before FGJ, New Orleans.

# ADMINISTRATIVE:

Investigative period of instant report overlaps that of referenced report as investigation by auxiliary offices not available prior to submission of referenced report.

This matter has been discussed with Departmental Attorney GISLESON, on several occasions, the last time being 12/2/69. He advised that he is in favor of subpoenaing both PROVENZANO and LEGAN before FGJ, but because of his relative tenure as a Departmental Attorney. He contacted his superiors in Washington, and they did not express any enthusiasm for this type of action, stating that they felt that this was "abuse of process", which the RAMSEY CLARK Administration adopted as policy, i.e. in bringing potential defendants before Grand Jury where a substantial case could not be proven. He stated he was in the process of preparing a memo to his superiors pointing out that it was highly unlikely that any prosecution at all could take place and it would be better to bring PROVENZANO and LEGAN before the Grand Jury. In hopes of perjuring or immunizing in an attempt to develop a prosecutive case against JAMES and other two Unknown subjects could be identified with the cooperation of either PROVENZANO or LEGAN.
