On 1/8/62 MM 509-C advised that VINCENT JAMES PALMISANO has been going to Tropical Race Track almost daily and on occasions books some of the bets of the individuals he goes with. In addition he learned PALMISANO is hanging around the Dunes Motel and prior to going to the track takes some bets there.

LEONARD DAYE, Investigator for the Florida Hotel Commission on 1/5/62 advised that on 12/29/61 he arrested SAM DI CARLO (Miami File 92-103) for interfering with an officer at his apartment 2851 Sheridan Road, Miami Beach, even though DI CARLO prior to his arrest flushed his wagering bets down a laboratory.

WILLIAM ROY ROBINSON (Miami File 165-58) was arrested by officers of the Dade County Department of Public Safety on 12/20/61. ROBINSON was spotted outside Tropical Race Track with a telescope trained on the tote board which reflects the results of a race. Ostensibly he was arrested on Bench Wamants issued for three old traffic tickets. ROBINSON was released on \$250 bond and is presently being checked by officers of the Department of Public Safety to determine if he is working for a wire service operator in Miami.

MM 786-C on 1/6/62 advised he observed ROBINSON driving a 1960 Pontiac, which ROBINSON parked at the Sundries Store of NEIL WINTERING (Miami File 165-20). MM 786-C also advised he observed ROBINSON conversing with RALPH SHEA, (Miami File 165-16).
