WEEKLY SUMMARY

PASQUALE MICHAEL ERRA (Miami file 92-648), on 4/6/62, observed to visit home of MICHAEL COPPOLA (Miami file 92-101), then go to home of MAX EDER (Miami file 92-467). From EDER's home they were observed to travel to the Rolling Hills Golf Club, Ft. Lauderdale, Fla., where they played golf as a two-some.

On 4/11/62, ANTHONY SALERNO (Miami file 92-406) observed entering ERRA's home at 3720 Chase Ave., Miami Beach, Fla., where he remained about one and a half hours. In the afternoon of 4/11/62 ERRA observed driving from his home to the Amvets Post #35, located at 23rd and Liberty, Miami Beach, where he remained about 20 minutes.

MM 509-C, on 4/3/62 advised the Amvets Post #35 Club lost their charter as an Amvets Club, but the name still remains on the door and window. This club has been a hang-out for bookmakers, gamblers and various other types of law

violators; it has principally been under the control of MICHAEL COPPOLA and is located on property owned by JOHN ANGERSOLA, aka., John King (Miami file 92-100). MM 509-C advised the "boys" are now referring to the club as the Midtown Social Club, which presently is closed during the day but opens about six or seven p.m. and remains open until two or three a.m., depending on the activity and action in the card games. This source also advised that inasmuch as COPPOLA is in prison, EDDIE GOLD, a bookmaker and part of the COPPOLA organization has been sending JACK GORDON over to the Sea Gull Hotel, Miami Beach, where numerous gamblers and bookmakers hang out, for the purpose of "laying off" some of the bets GOLD receives.

MM 675-C, on 3/21/62 advised he heard HAROLD SOLOMON, a bail bondsman at Miami Beach, makes a bail bond for anyone sent by JOSEPH INDELICATO (Miami file 92-404) and it is rumored that INDELICATO has some interest in the Harold Solomon Bail Bonds concern.

KENNETH SKATTEGARD, Investigator for the Florida Attorney General's Office, Miami, Fla., on 4/7/62 advised ALPHONSE MARZANO, Sr., age 72 and DONALD ORLANDO, age 57, were arrested for bookmaking at Apartment #7, 1850 NE 167th St., North Miami Beach, and that he questioned MARZANO re the ELUM ADDIE CAUDELL (Miami file 165-6) Wire Service or other wire service outfits and MARZANO replied "You know there isn't any wire service now". SKATTEGARD also stated MARZANO is the father of ALPHONSE MARZANO, Jr., age 30, of 729 NE 3rd St., Hallandale, Fla., who was arrested at Gulfstream Race Track on 3/15/62 for disseminating race results from the track by hand signals.

MM 788-C\* furnished info that HYMAN MARTIN (Miami file 92-218) is giving consideration toward starting a local lottery which will have as the winning number the number picked in the Mexican National Lottery.
