On July 2, 1969, the Bundeskriminalamt (BKA - West German Federal Criminal Police) advised that, according to information from the State Police in Bavaria, West Germany, dated June 30, 1969, the subject was then staying, with his wife, at 12 Marthabraeustrasse, Fuerstenfeldbruck, Federal Republic of Germany. The couple had already been at that address for about five days. It is not possible to determine their plans for departure.

Bonn's previous file on ALEX was destroyed in accordance with Bureau-approved procedures on September 13, 1968. It is our recollection that the Fuerstenfeldbruck address is the home of the mother of subject's wife, formerly SUZANNE FUEGER.
