No. 3 Western Union telegram dated 6/6/68, to the Honorable GUSTAVO DIAZ ORDAZ, Palacio de Gobierno, Mexico, D.F.:

"Disregarding the petitions of the Cuban people, it obliges us to give an ultimatum of war against your Government unless you suspend all commerce with the Cuban Communists regime. If you do not do this, you will be the one responsible for the Mexican ships and planes that will be dynamited. To avoid further mishaps, don't make the mistake of under estimating this advice from Cuban power.

Cuban Power"

The envelope in which the above described telegram forms were received is postmarked Miami, Florida, and dated 6/7/68. It is addressed "The Honorable Ambassador of Estados Unidos de México to the United States, Mexican Embassy, Washington, D.C."

SIERRA further advised that the MPD is affording protection to the Mexican Embassy.
