Crime Conditions in Jefferson Parish, Louisiana

Previous communications have pointed out that there has been considerable publicity in New Orleans newspapers about "Wide Open" gambling now in progress in Jefferson Parish, the parish immediately adjacent to the City of New Orleans.

On 1/21/64, NO 1205-C who is an operator of casino type gambling, advised that although the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office was taking no action to stop gambling, any place in the parish, the Old Southport Club is the only casino offering gambling with dice. Informant stated that there is a blackjack table and a roulette wheel at the Cotton Club on Jefferson Highway, but there can be no dice tables at this place. Informant said that JOSEPH O'DYER who operates the gambling at the Cotton Club does not have to pay off to any official in Jefferson Parish in order to be permitted to conduct gambling at this place.

On 1/9/64, NO 1227-PC a pimp advised that he is convinced that Sheriff Elect ALWYNN J. CRONVICH will vigorously enforce all local laws when he takes office as Sheriff in Jefferson Parish in May of 1964. NO 1227-PC stated that all pimps and gamblers in Jefferson Parish are already making plans to leave the parish prior to the time that CRONVICH takes office. He stated that even such perennial places as the New Garden Club, a gambling casino in Gretna, Louisiana and
